The Bookmark Bookstore Celebrates 20 Years in Old Oakland!

It took courage and vision for the Friends of the Oakland Public Library to make the decision in the early 1990's to abandon their occasional book sales in favor of investing in a more permanent site. Today the light-filled, mostly volunteer-run store that serves as the main fund-raising arm for the library is 20 years old and a successful model for other Friends organizations!

To mark this occasion, the Friends are inviting the public to join them for a weeklong **Anniversary celebration** in the Bookmark Bookstore, 721 Washington Street, from November 5 – 11, 2012. During this week, the Bookmark will extend the **20% discount** available to FOPL members to anyone who makes a purchase at the store. To encourage new members, FOPL will also offer - during this week only - a special membership rate of \$20.00, a \$5.00 discount from the regular individual rate. Seniors (65+) and full-time students are always eligible to join for just \$15.00.

The Bookmark will also host a special **Anniversary Raffle**. Everybody will have a chance to win prizes from local businesses by purchasing tickets (\$5.00 each or 5 for \$20.00) from the store during normal business hours. The winners will be drawn at the anniversary party on November 14th, and raffle ticket holders do not have to be present to win.

To encourage kids to become early readers, FOPL has designated Saturday, November 10th, as **Kids' Day**. Every child who visits the store on this day may select one free book. On this Saturday, they will also be admitted free at nearby MOCHA (the Museum of Children's Art), 538 Ninth Street, by showing their library cards. (MOCHA hosts a 1 p.m. story hour and book-related art project on the second Saturday of each month.)

A 20th Anniversary Birthday Bash to thank members and volunteers will cap off the week on Wednesday, November 14, 2012, 6:30-9:00, at Cosecha Restaurant in Swan's Market, 907 Washington Street. An author program will feature local writers and library supporters Charlie Haas (*The Enthusiast* and screenplays such as *Tex*, *Gremlins 2*), Adam David Miller (*Ticket to Exile: A Memoir*), children's author Marrisa Moss (the *Amelia Notebooks*, *Sky High*) and Lisa Schoonover (*The Indigo Butterfly*). Light refreshments will be catered by Cosecha with a "no host" wine tasting by Periscope Cellars and desserts by Pietisserie. Music will be provided by D. Edward (Dale Chung). This gala event is free and is by invitation only. (*Please note that anyone who joins FOPL on or before November 11 will receive an invitation*).

FOPL's 2012 Grants to the Library

FOPL's mission is to support the Oakland Public Library through advocacy, volunteerism and financial support. In keeping with the last of these roles, the FOPL board approved grants to the Library in the amount of \$138,000 at its July 2012 meeting.

- Grants for materials, programming and projects at branches, including 81st Avenue, AAMLO, Asian, Brookfield, Chavez, Dimond, Elmhurst, Lakeview, Melrose, Temescal and West Oakland, and the Main library.
- Systemwide support for Children's and Teen services, Second Start Adult Literacy and scholarships for library staff pursuing their masters degree in library and information science.
- "Makeover Fund" for branch refurbishment projects for three branches—Brookfield, Dimond and Montclair--over the next two years. FOPL funds will also serve as a match for a generous foundation grant that is available for these projects.

The Piedmont Avenue Branch Library is Moving

The Oakland City Council approved the Library's proposal to enter into a lease with the Oakland Unified School District for a modular facility that will serve as the new branch library for the Piedmont Avenue neighborhood. In late October the branch will close in order to prepare for the move from 41st Street to a new home on the Piedmont Avenue Elementary School grounds, near the corner of Echo and Glen Avenues.
